Current Projects & Some of the Things That You Can Do

- ✓ Contribute to a Food Bank: CP residents have donated 9 tons of food to CORA, a local food bank providing food to families who often do not have enough to eat.
- ✓ <u>Tutor or Mentor Students or Help Teachers</u>: More than 20 CP volunteers help out at Cary's Kingwood Elementary School on a weekly basis.
- ✓ <u>Serve or Prepare Meals at a Local Shelter</u>: CPC has several shifts in the early to mid-morning several days a month.
- ✓ Sew Quilts for Children Who Live in the Family Section of a Homeless Shelter
- ✓ Donate Clothing and Children's Books for Families and Children Living in Shelters:
- ✓ Participate in CPC's Guardian Angel Program in which Holiday Gifts are Purchased for Children Who Would Not Otherwise Receive Any: In 2014, gifts were provided to 130 children.
